ASK LEGISLATORS TO HELP MEET THE NEED

INCREASE ADULT EDUCATION BASE FUNDING BY \$10 MILLION TO IMPROVE ACCESS TO SERVICES STATEWIDE AND ELIMINATE WAITING LISTS FOR CLASSES.

- The gross revenue per contact hour cap, currently \$30 per hour, would raise to \$36 per hour, and
- The cap on growth in contact hour revenue, currently the greater of 11% or \$10,000 would be suspended for the funding year 2025-2026. For future years, the cap would be raise to the greater of 11% or \$12,000.

Adult Education programs are experiencing:

- · significant program growth & costs
- · shrinking instructional hours due to funding limits
- constrained capacity to partner with employers, DEED, & post-secondary programs
- need for HSE/GED testing support in Greater Minnesota

BASE FUNDING OF UP TO \$250,000/YEAR FOR THE HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY (HSE/GED) ONE-FREE TEST FUNDING.

Need is high. \$460,000 was allocated for 3 years; however, more than \$200,000 was used in the first year.
